*Please note that the exact dosage depends of different factors, like; type of crop/plant, type of soil, climate and soil condition. The dosages vary between 10 to 30 kilos per 100 m².

Are you developing a new garden?

Apply 1 kg per 2 m² and work it into the ground well. When you plant new crops or move them, mix ½ kg of pellets in the planting hole.
